General Information

Educational Objectives

Accreditation

Application has been made to the American Academy of Family Physicians (AAFP) for Prescribed CME credit. AAFP Prescribed credit is accepted by the AMA as equivalent to AMA PRA Category 1 credit for the AMA Physicians Recognition Award. Updated credit verification certificates will be included in the registration packets. Attendees of sessions provided by other CME providers, which are incorporated in the 2010 MAFP Assembly CME program, will receive appropriate certificates at those sessions.

Portions of the program may be approved by AAFP for Evidence Based Medicine (EBM) Credits. Attendees of EBM-approved presentations may claim double credit for those sessions.

MAFP-member registrants must report their credits to AAFP. Registrants may claim only those hours of credit actually spent in educational activities.

MAFP CME Requirement (MAFP Members Only)

Credits from this conference are applicable to both the AAFP and MAFP CME requirements for membership. MAFP Active and Supporting Members are required to obtain six (6) AAFP Prescribed credits every three (3) years from MAFP sponsored programs.
