During the SAM you will explore the questions and engage in clinical discussion. At the end of the 4-hour session, your answers to the sixty-question knowledge assessment (Part A) will automatically be sent to the ABFM on your behalf. You are guaranteed a passing grade for Part A as a participant in this study group. This year's SAM Study Hall, which requires separate registration and fee, will focus on Early Childhood Illness. After you complete the clinical simulation portion of the module (Part B), you can claim up to 15 AAFP PRESCRIBED CME credits (also equivalent to AMA Category I credits).
