Take I-195 West to I-95 North. Follow I-95 to I-695 (the Baltimore Beltway). Take I-695 North towards Towson (**Left-lane exit!**). From I-695, take the I-83 exit North towards York, PA. Five miles North of the I-695/I-83 interchange is exit 20, for Shawan Road East. Take this exit, the hotel is at the bottom of the ramp on the right.

From Pennsylvania & points north:

Take I-95 South to I-695. Take the I-695 exit West towards Towson. From I-695, take the I-83 exit North towards York, PA. Five miles North of the I-695/I-83 interchange is exit 20, for Shawan Road East. Take this exit, the hotel is at the bottom of the ramp on the right.

From Washington, DC & points south:

Take I-95 North until you reach I-695. Take the **left-lane exit** North towards Towson onto I-695. From I-695, take I-83 North towards York, PA. Five miles North of the I-695/I-83 interchange is exit 20, for Shawan Road East. Take this exit, the hotel is at the bottom of the ramp on the right.
